

# Pool Rules

1. There shall be no solo swimming.
2. There shall be no running, boisterous or rough play.
3. No use of or person under the influence of alcohol or drugs permitted at the pool.
4. There shall be no spitting or blowing nose in pool.
5. Persons with communicable diseases shall not enter the pool.
6. Persons with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections shall not enter the pool.
7. No animals or pets allowed in pool.
8. No glass allowed in pool or on deck.
9. No children shall be at the pool without adult supervision.
10. Please take a shower before entering the pool.
11. This pool is open from 8 AM to 10 PM.
12. No more than 5 guests per household allowed at the pool without expressed written permission of the HOA.
13. An emergency phone is located by the water fountain.

## **Additionally:**

- The gate at the pool entrance must remain closed at all times. Please ensure that the gate is closed behind you when entering and leaving the pool area.
- Please dispose of your trash (wrappers, food items, cans, etc.) before you leave the pool.
- If you are the last to leave, please turn off the lights in the bathrooms and close the doors. This will prevent bugs from gathering and help save expenses on electricity and replacing light bulbs.
- Please do not leave swimming apparel or pool toys at the pool. This will prevent items from being lost or discarded.
- Smoking is no permitted at the pool.

Your cooperation in adhering to these rules and guidelines is key to ensuring that the pool remains an enjoyable, safe, and relaxing place for the neighborhood, and to protect and preserve the investment of our most expensive asset as a community.
